

United States

A safety data sheet is not required for Abbott Nutrition products, according to the OSHA Hazard Communication Standard, 29 CFR 1910.1200. These products are considered food as defined in 29 CFR 1910.1200(b)(6)(vi)—to which the requirements of the Hazard Communication Standard do not apply.

They are also exempted from the labeling requirements of this standard under 29 CFR 1910.1200(b)(5)(iii)—which exempts foods, drugs, cosmetics, medical devices and similar items, when they are subject to the labeling requirements under the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act (21 U.S.C. 301 *et seq.*) and the regulations issued pursuant to that Act.

European Union

A safety data sheet is not required for Abbott Nutrition products, and they are also exempted from labeling requirements according to the:

- European Communities (Classification, Packaging, Labelling & Notification of Dangerous Substances) Regulations,
- Annex I of REACH Regulation 453/2010, and/or
- Dangerous Substances Directive 67/548/EEC

Singapore

A safety data sheet is not required for Abbott Nutrition products, according to the Singapore Workplace Safety and Health Act (Chapter 354A, Section 65) Workplace Safety and Health (General Provisions) Regulations, Clause 44.

India
