

YOUR TOP QUESTIONS FOR TESTING WHILE TRAVELING INTERNATIONALLY

Abbott and United announced a first-of-its-kind partnership to offer the BinaxNOW™ COVID-19 Ag Card Home Test and NAVICA™ app – providing peace of mind on return trips to the U.S. for international travelers. Testing while traveling may be new for many people, so we're here to answer your top questions.



WHICH COVID-19 TEST IS BEING USED?

Abbott's BinaxNOW Home Test, a rapid antigen test that can be done from your hotel. The BinaxNOW Self Test available over the counter at retail should not be used.

WHO'S ELIGIBLE?

U.S. residents on return flights to the U.S. from international travel.

WHEN IS THIS NEEDED?

When you are coming back to the U.S. from an international trip. The CDC requires proof of negative COVID-19 test results (NAAT or antigen) before boarding flights traveling into the U.S.

HOW DOES BINAXNOW WORK?

A simple nasal swab placed in a card that requires no instrumentation. An eMed virtual certified guide will walk you through the process.

WHEN DO I GET MY RESULTS?

You can expect your results to arrive in about 20 minutes in the NAVICA app. If test results are negative, eMed will send a digital health certificate with a QR code via NAVICA. United accepts that as proof of your negative test result. If results are positive, you'll need to quarantine and consult with the airline and local health authorities.

WHAT DO I NEED TO DO?



ORDER YOUR TEST

United's Travel-Ready Center gives you the option to purchase Abbott's BinaxNOW Home Tests through eMed, which will be shipped to you before your flight.



PACK YOUR TEST IN YOUR CARRY-ON

Passengers receive the tests in the mail and pack the unopened tests in their carry-on bag.



CONDUCT THE TEST BEFORE YOUR FLIGHT HOME

No more than three days before departing, the traveler logs into the eMed platform where a live certified guide walks you through the testing process.



GET YOUR NAVICA DIGITAL HEALTH CERTIFICATE

If test results are negative, eMed will send a digital health certificate through the NAVICA app. If a test result is positive or inconclusive, United's Travel-Ready Center can help the passenger with additional information.

The BinaxNOW™ COVID-19 Ag Card Home Test is a lateral flow immunoassay intended for the qualitative detection of nucleocapsid protein antigen from SARS-CoV-2. This test is authorized for prescription home use with self-collected observed direct anterior nasal (nares) swab samples from individuals aged 15 years or older who are suspected of COVID-19 by their healthcare provider within the first seven days of symptom onset or adult collected nasal swab samples from individuals aged four years or older who are suspected of COVID-19 by their healthcare provider within the first seven days of symptom onset.

The BinaxNOW COVID-19 Ag Card Home Test is to be performed only with the supervision of a telehealth proctor.
